Cold-Brew Iced Tea

- 8 cups cold water
 - 4 herbal tea bags
 - Sugar, for serving
1. Fill a 2-quart pitcher or drink dispenser with 8 cups of cold water.
 2. Submerge the tea bags in the water, letting the tags hang over the pitcher or dispenser. Let the tea steep in the refrigerator for 8 to 12 hours or overnight.
 3. Remove and discard the tea bags. Serve the iced tea in ice-filled cups, offering sugar on the side in packets or in a covered dish with a spoon.

Selena's Version

- 8 cups cold water
 - 6 black tea bags
 - Sugar, for serving
 - Lemon slices, for serving
1. Fill a 2-quart pitcher or drink dispenser with 8 cups of cold water.
 2. Submerge the tea bags in the water, letting the tags hang over the pitcher or dispenser. Let the tea steep in the refrigerator for 8 to 12 hours or overnight.
 3. Remove and discard the tea bags. Serve the iced tea in ice-filled cups, offering sugar and lemon slices on the side.
